# Bug Reports

- **When** - application doesn't act the way it is supposed to
- **What** - a report that tells us what the application is doing that differs from how you expect it to work
- **Why** - to help us to improve the software for the benefit of the Dataverse Community
- **Who** - anyone in the community who experiences an issue and would like to contribute to improving the quality of the software
- **Where and How** - next slide...

# Change Requests

- **When** - you would like the application to do something different from the way it behaves now.
- **What** - a report that tells us the behavior you would like to see; either a change or additional functionality.
- **Why, Who, Where and How** - same as Bug Reports
