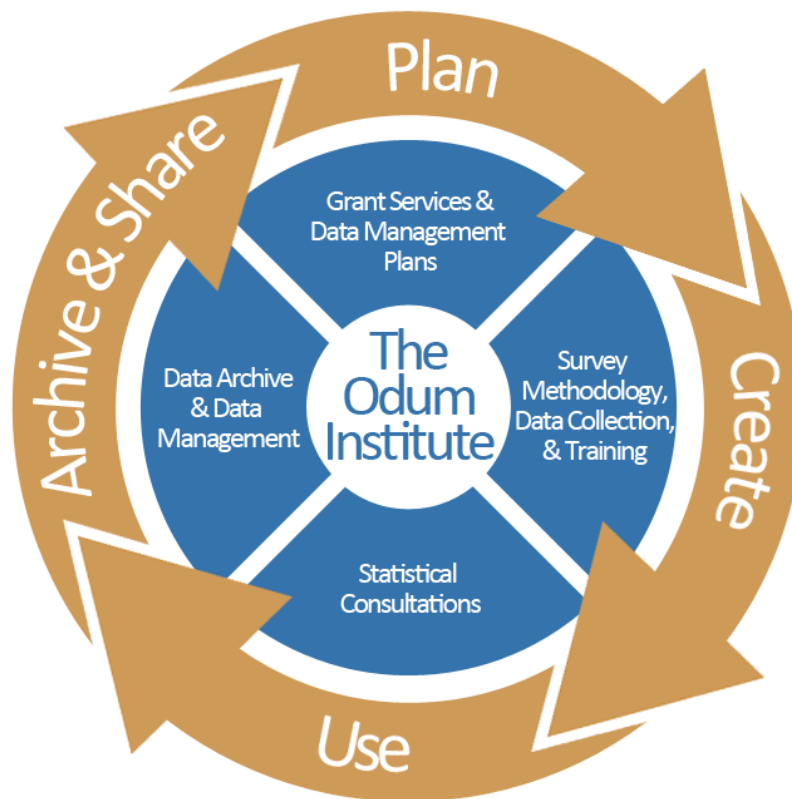

OUR MISSION

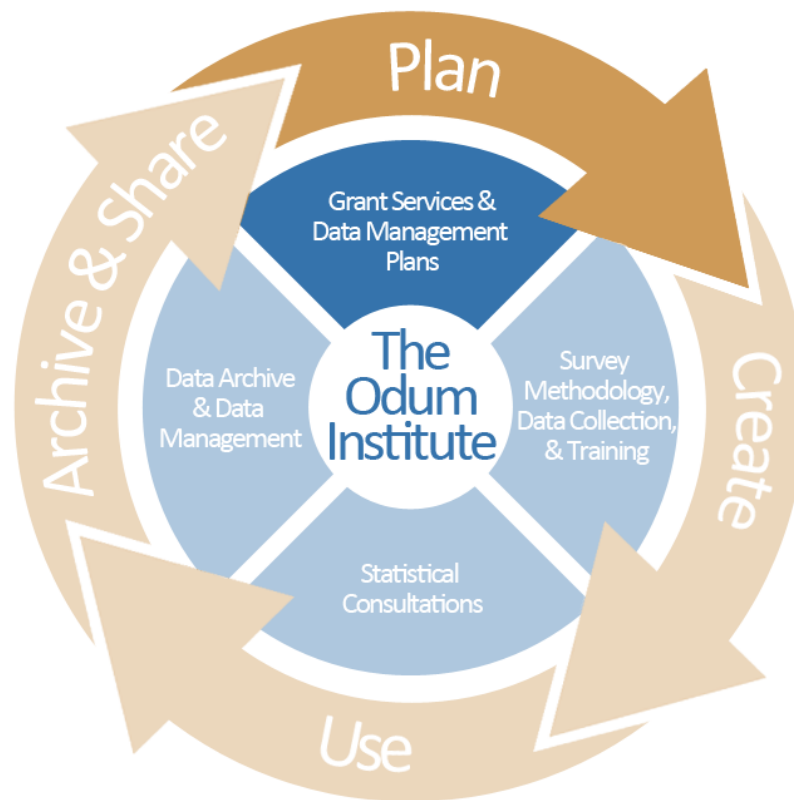

MEASURE Evaluation is the USAID Global Health Bureau's primary vehicle for supporting improvements in monitoring and evaluation in population, health and nutrition worldwide. We help to identify data needs, collect and analyze technically sound data, and use that data for health decision making. Some MEASURE Evaluation activities involve the collection of innovative evaluation data sets in order to increase the evidence-base on program impact and evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of recent evaluation methodological developments. Many of these data sets may be available to other researchers to answer questions of particular importance to global health and evaluation research. Some of these data sets are being added to the Dataverse on a rolling basis, as they become available.

Data management is most successful when data management practices are implemented throughout the research lifecycle.



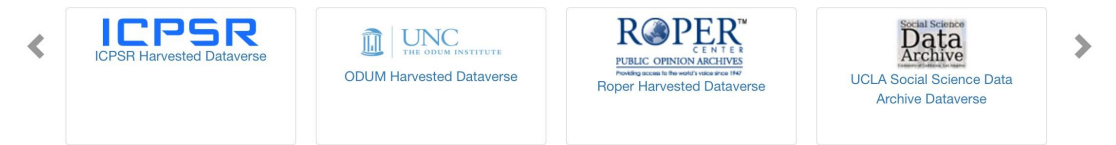
